



Why did we undertake this survey?

- We wanted to find out from our members and other colleagues working in local trusts in clinical audit and other QI:
 - what training & development is needed
 - their views on local clinical audit in terms of structure, alignment with other QI, barriers & resources
 - how we are doing – nationally and regionally
 - Collect ideas on how we can improve both our networks & Clinical Audit & other QI going forward
- Aim of using feedback to form basis of objectives for 2019/20 – both nationally and regionally
- Send report to NHS England on local clinical audit and offer solutions and develop / expand our networks infrastructure and budget (currently at £16K +£5k for my protected time as chair)



Survey Methods & Limitations

- NQICAN Task & Finish Group set up to develop survey (3 regional network chairs - Denise Thompson, Sarah Chessell, Vicky Patel, and NQICAN officers - Julie Hancock and myself) focused around aims
- Survey signed off by all network chairs / N-QI-CAN officers before sent out.
- Designed by Amanda Tracey, UHL Clinical Audit Facilitator using online CRT software.
- **Survey period:** 1 month (14/2 to 13/3/19)
- Timing not ideal as Clinical Audit Support Centre Annual State of Clinical Audit sent out in December similar audience – no duplication in questioning.
- Sent out to our regional network members by network chairs and link posted on NNSF. Follow-up reminder sent 2 weeks in.
- Incentive offered to complete survey – entered into a prize draw for a place at the Summit – link to separate survey at end (Well done to Bethany)
- Draft results shared last week at NQICAN meeting and today with headlines only and our plans going forward aligned to today's debate.
